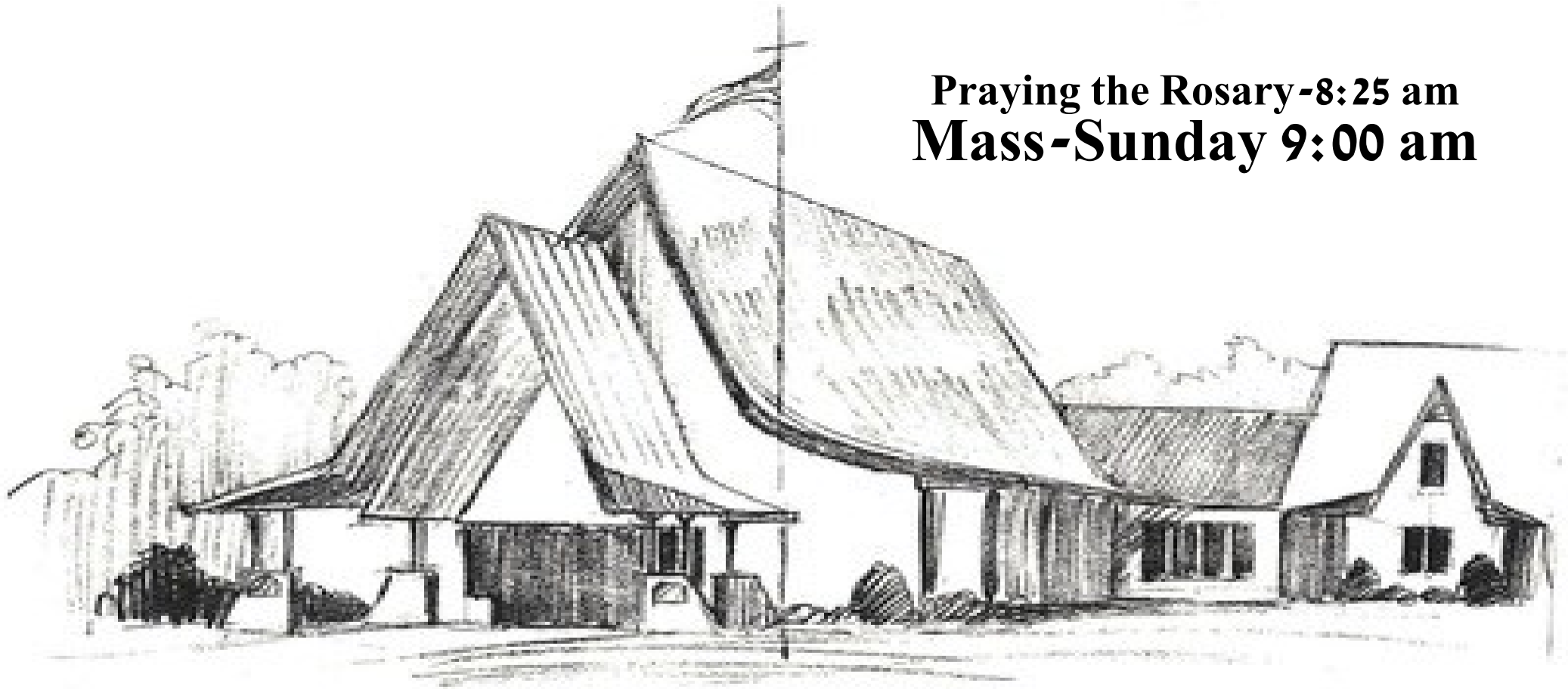

From the Senior Parochial Vicar's Desk



Faith is something that we can never have too much of. It enables us to trust and gives us assurance that we are loved and cared for by God.

Jesus often tells people that their faith has healed them when he cures them of illness or injury. Therefore, faith can also motivate us to take action and approach Jesus with confidence that He can bring about healing.

Today's Gospel contains two stories of Jesus' healing where He speaks about faith. He tells the woman afflicted with hemorrhages that her faith has healed her. He tells the family of the synagogue official to have faith that his daughter has not died but is just sleeping. Jesus also tells them not to be afraid.

Fear can cause a lack of faith in us. That's why Jesus often tells people not to be afraid. He is with us throughout whatever pain and suffering we may be experiencing.

Let us ask God each day to ever increase our faith so that we may meet the challenges in our lives knowing and trusting that He is with us always.
